Emergency Care Team

Position Overview

Provide support and encouragement for SBS moms in emergency situations.

Key Responsibilities

- Be ready and available to show up for emergency situations with SBS moms including:
 - Court appearances
 - Medical emergencies/appointments
- Act as a representative of SBS with SBS moms and community professionals.
- Communicate immediately with staff regarding situations with SBS moms, including reporting any concerns.

Training & Support

- Attend 2 hour orientation and training on September 4 to review duties and expectations.
- Support from staff as needed.

Commitment

- Commitment is for one program year from September to April
- Hours will vary depending on situations. You will be added to a list of people that the staff can call outside of office hours to show up for emergency situations.

Qualifications/Skills

- Flexible and easygoing
- Committed to personal spiritual growth by participating in the following:
 - Active participation in community with other believers
 - Consistent Bible reading
 - Prayer and spending time alone with God
- Commit to maintaining a godly lifestyle including abstinence outside of marriage.
- Maintain appropriate social media presence refraining from lewd or inappropriate content.
- Adhere to the SBS Statement of Faith
- Be able to provide non-judgmental support to SBS moms coming from different faiths, beliefs, or lifestyles.
- Have valid auto insurance, driver's license, and reliable transportation. Able to provide transportation to SBS mom and children for meetings.
- Background check required.
