Awana Leader

Revive Kid's Ministry

Position Overview

Responsible for leading a small group of children through the Awana curriculum including Bible lesson, scripture memory, songs, games, and building relationships with the children.

Awana Leaders will be offered a stipend of \$10/hr.

Key Responsibilities

- Arrive promptly by 6:00 pm on Thursday Revive nights.
- Review and prepare curriculum provided for Awana lesson.
- Teach Awana lesson to the children, encouraging them to memorize Scripture verses to earn badges.
- Lead songs, games, and crafts corresponding with Awana lessons.
- Responsible for managing other volunteers within the room.
- Ensure rooms are cleaned up at the end of program nights, returned to their prior state
- Be comfortable handling messes such as runny noses, diapers, temper tantrums, and meltdowns.
- Adhere to child care safety rules, including handling incidents and following clear procedures to complete paperwork and communicate with staff and SBS moms.
- Report any issues or concerns regarding other child care room workers to Children's Ministry Coordinator.

Training and Support

- Complete online Awana training provided by SBS.
- Attend a 2 hour orientation and training to review duties and expectations.
- Must complete CPR certification training.
- Support from Children's Ministry Coordinator as needed.

Commitment

- Commitment is for 1 program year from September to April
- 12-15 hours per month including weekly Revive on Thursday nights and prep time for lessons
- Must notify SBS of anticipated absence from program night two (2) weeks in advance
- Allowed 2 absences from program nights for the year
